

Surgical Wounds (M1340 and M1342)

Surgical Wounds	Not Surgical Wounds
Pressure ulcers with muscle flaps	Pressure ulcers with skin grafts Pressure ulcers sutured closed
Dialysis cath exit sites Implanted infusion devices ON-Q catheter sites	PICC lines and peripheral lines
Cardiac cath by cutdown	Cardiac cath by puncture
I&D with drain Excision (even when documented as I&D) Wound with drain even after drain pulled	I&D without drain Paracentesis
Shave, punch or excisional biopsy	Removal of a callus
Repair of a internal trauma	Repair of a traumatic laceration
Take down of ostomy	Thoracotomy or any wound ending is otomy (ostomy) Ostomy allowed to close on its own
Pacemakers until epithelialized for 30 days	Pacemakers once epithelialized for 30 days
VP shunt	
Donor site for grafts	Graft sites for burns, pressure ulcers, etc
Arthroscopy	Retention sutures Cataract surgery Gynecological surgery via vaginal approach Mucous membranes (dental)
